Your school can host a meaningful experience that combines large-scale art, hands-on student engagement, and a message that helps every student recognize their value.

Artist Tim Gibson, founder of the Ten Thousand Flowers Project, is traveling across the country to lead mural workshops in partnership with Worthwhile's "Words of Worth" initiative. Together, this project helps schools and communities come together to create a lasting, visual reminder that each student matters.

How It Works

- ▶ Tim spends about two weeks on campus starting with preparing and outlining the mural
- Students, teachers, families, and community members paint the mural during workshop sessions (like a giant paint-by-numbers), usually held during art class
- The experience ends with a schoolwide assembly and unveiling, introducing the "Words of Worth" message
